

Affidavit of Jayrene Engichy

I, Jayrene Engichy, and adult of sound mind and body make the following statements under oath:

1. That I am a resident of Chuuk State and a citizen of the Federated States of Micronesia;
2. That I am one of several sons and daughters of John Engichy;
3. That my father John Engichy did convey and grant the title to us, his sons and daughters, title of the land, Lot No. 61602, part of Fais, located on Nepukos, Weno, Chuuk State in June 2010;
4. That I and my sisters and brothers have been living outside of Chuuk State in the Mainland, USA, seeking better education;
5. That our father, John Engichy had been providing financial assistances to us in the USA to help pay for our living expenses there and our schools' obligations;
6. That because of his situation, he was unable to provide any financial assistances which we need very badly, thus, in September 2012, in order to provide financial supports for us all, he attempted to sell our land to one Ray Andrew Macayon but was unable to consummate the sale because he has already given the title of the land to us;
7. That I had to sign another deed of sale to revalidate the one he signed so that the seller can obtain the necessary certificate of title which was called for in the agreement;
8. That I am still living in the United States to continue furthering my education and that I need some portion of the money which the purchaser of our land has been paying directly to the court;
9. That I am appealing to the Mercy and Grace of the Court to modify the judgment to allow at least one third of the monthly payment to be paid to me and the rest to be paid as ordered by the court;
