

6 The Court has received and reviewed Plaintiffs' Motion For Approval Of
7 Proposed Settlement Agreement, Plaintiffs' memoranda in support of that Motion and
8 the exhibits attached thereto and the authorities cited therein, and other papers filed
9 with respect to the motion and the entire record in this case.

10 NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

11 1. No Opt Outs. The Court finds that no member of the Class
12 defined in that certain Order filed May 8, 2012 has opted out of the class within the
13 period allowed by the Order Conditionally Certifying Class and Preliminary Order of
14 Approval filed on 5/27/13, 2013.


15 2. The Court finds that there have been no successful challenges to
16 any aspect of the resolution of this action, including class certification, settlement, or
17 dismissal.

18 3. Settlement Fairness. Upon due notice to the Class, and upon
19 having conducted a fairness hearing pursuant to FSM Civ. R. 23(e) as made applicable
20 by FSM Civ. R. 23.2, the Court finds the settlement between the Plaintiffs and the
21 Defendants to be reasonable and fair. The Court also finds the express conditions of
22 the Settlement set forth in the parties' Stipulation For Settlement and General Release,
23 filed on 5/24, 2013, to have been satisfied. Accordingly, the
24 Settlement is hereby approved.


25 4. Plan for Use, Investment and Distribution of Settlement Proceeds.




