DUTIES: (ILLUSTRATIVE ONLY)

Carry out traditional ombudsman activities for the Supreme Court of the Federated States of Micronesia in the State; serve as liaison between the Court and the community, including traditional and governmental leaders; to develop more effective and appropriate methods of resolving disputes, including alternatives to Courts; work as clerk of the Supreme Court of the Federated States of Micronesia in the State; provide pre-sentence reports on convicted offenders; interview and counsel offenders; assist the Court in working with persons qualified to serve as assessors under section 12 of the National Judiciary Act, 4 FSM Code 113; provide information to the public concerning the vernacular and vice versa; administer oaths, provide translation during court proceedings, and may act as a public notary; assist in the maintenance preservation and acquisition of library materials; counsel delinquent juveniles to determine and recommend rehabilitative measures; work with parents and the community to make them aware and responsive to juvenile problems; performs other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Graduation from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree in any social science or related field plus at least three (3) years of work experience in office management or counseling. Work experience in Court, Public Safety, Youth Program and other related areas may substitute year for year for the required education. Must have good command of English and at least one of the local languages in FSM including a local language commonly used in the State where the person is to serve.
